I understand that if I fail to pay all dockage due, I may be cited for violation of California Penal Code Section 537, which states: "Any person who obtains foods, fuel, services, or accommodations at a marina, marina facility...without paying thereof, with intent to defraud the proprietor or manager thereof... is guilty of a public offense."

3.05.170 Vessels with valid liveaboard permits, used as residences

A. No vessel berthed in the marinas of Oyster Point Marina/Park or Pillar Point Harbor shall be used as a place of residence except as authorized by the Director of Operations.

B. Any vessel used for overnight accommodation between the hours of ten p.m. and six a.m. for more than three (3) nights in a seven (7) day period shall be considered a residence. A request in writing to the Director of Operations for a reasonable extension of time, i.e., vacation, temporary or visitor's berthing, or extenuating circumstances, will be considered. Written approval from the Director of Operations must be received prior to the fourth night of remaining on board the vessel.
