Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Board of Harbor Commissioners hereby endorses the City of South San Francisco's Oyster Point public restroom project and authorizes staff to work with City staff to identify a site and to prepare a Memorandum of Understanding for adoption by City and District to guide project implementation and income and expense allocation and reimbursement.
