Jim,

There is a change in the language in the fish sales from vessels permit application that I am requesting to not be changed, specifically, paragraph 2 of the current rules.

The legacy and current rules state "sales are to take place at the berth holders slip". The proposed rules state " Permittee is allowed to conduct business in the vessel's assigned berth or fish sales dock".

This may seem to be an insignificant change but the change will negatively affect my operation. Before purchasing a second vessel, the business decision to purchase this vessel was based on the ability sell retail vs as selling the catch at local buyers. The difference in revenue is substantial. The temporary swapping of slips I rent, for sale purposes only, was discussed with the previous harbormaster. He agreed that this was acceptable since I own both vessels and rent both slips. Hence the purchase of another vessel went forward. There are several others that are in this same situation as myself that may not have caught this wording change.
