Whereas, this amendment will require additional modification to the Oyster Point Marina/Park budget contained in the 2015-2016 Integrated Operating Budget.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Board of Harbor Commissioners authorizes the Interim General Manager to enter into an amendment to the contract with Cox, Wooten, Lerner, Griffin, Hansen & Poulos LLP to increase the not to exceed contract amount by an additional \$25,000; and

Be it Further Resolved, that the Board of Harbor Commissioners approves an Amendment to the Final Integrated Operating and Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 2015-16 of \$25,000 as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein, be adopted for Fiscal Year 2015-16.
