










































DESIGN IDEAS Plan TO KEEP

Overall organization and orientation is straightforward and appropriate for the context

Function

Adequately-sized covered area, defined public Meet-up space

Maintenance

Durable material - concrete able to withstand harsh marine conditions and heavy use

Views

Oriented towards Surfers Beach



DESIGN ISSUES TO DEVELOP

Security

Individual closed and lockable rooms with sinks encourage unintended use

Unable to sense if person is inside stall

Function

No separate private changing area other than inside the stall

Maintenance

Wall mounted showers collect moisture on wall and seating, build up against wall

Cost

Extensive tall (15 ft) concrete walls

Diagonal framing and long roof span

ADA Access & Circulation

Access to restroom through parking stalls (no dedicated access)

Restroom use distracts from gathering space

Sheltered gathering space directly outside bathroom stalls









DESIGN IDEAS

Security

A common room w/ individual toilets in semi-private stalls Screens provide visual access Single common sink out in open Stainless bathroom stall partitions, more like a park restroom

Function

Restrooms, Meet-up space, & showers separated. Walls between each toilet, for adjacent privacy

Durable Low Maintenance

Showers on columns away from building structure Durable concrete base, stainless steel fixtures & partitions

Cost Efficient

Shorter roof spans Common sink with fewer fixtures Simple cantilever pavilion structure

ADA Access & Circulation

Dedicated pedestrian access from day use parking Showers separated from seating areas

Environment

Skylights for natural light and ventilation in each stall Parking aligned to maximize stormwater capture Walls & screens provided to block NW winds


Views

Views allowed into common sink area for safety Meet-up space & benches with views to Surfers Beach

















































